Stories from the Sacred Books

Muhammad and the Black Stone	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Muhammad instructed leaders of each tribe to take one corner of the cloth and they carried the stone together. This story teaches Muslims to be fair, work together and that it is good to be trustworthy.
The Good Samaritan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A traveller is beaten up, robbed and left for dead along the road. He was ignored by people going past. Finally a Samaritan helped the injured man in an act of compassion This story teaches Christians we should treat others the way we want to be treated
The Story of Moses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Thousands of years ago the Jews were living as slaves in Egypt. Their leader was a prophet called Moses. Moses led the Jews out of slavery in Egypt and led them to the Holy Land that God had promised them. The escape of the Jews from Egypt is remembered by Jews every year in the festival of Passover.
