## RE knowledge - Judaism

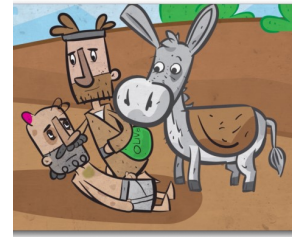
Jewish people build "Sukkah" huts for the week long festival of Sukkot. It is topped with branches and during the festival many will eat, sleep spend time in their Sukkah huts. It helps Jewish people remember when their God looked after the Israelites in Egypt.

Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish new year. During this festival Jewish people celebrate God making the world.

Tzedekah is the Jewish word for giving charitably.
